I just wanted to send everyone pictures of what a good snake looks like and what a bad one looks like. The speckled looking one is a King. These are very beneficial to have around, are not typically aggressive, so if you see them, please leave them be and they will leave you alone. They do an excellent job of eating rodents and are also experts on killing and eating copperheads, so we want them there.

Copperheads are the banded ones. They also are not typically aggressive, but we are permitted to dispatch them if you are confident you can do so without getting hurt. Otherwise, also please leave them alone and make a board member or range captain aware of them and we will handle it.

Just wanted to make sure everyone is watching their step in the woods, as the weather is getting warmer, the snakes will be out.



## 2015 Cowtown Club Championship Standings after 3 of 4 shoots


