
# MEMBERSHIP DRIVE SHOOT AND SEASON OPENER Jan. 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013



#### Safety Guidelines For Shooters

- Do not intentionally shoot arrows into the ground.
- Only point bow at intended target.
- Never nock an arrow until the intended target is clear of other shooters.
- Stay on designated paths.
- Look for arrows only after competition is completed for the day.
- If returning to look for lost arrows place a marker or your equipment in front of the target.
- Adults must supervise children at all times.
- Draw weight should be such that shooters are able to draw and aim their bow with control and without undue physical discomfort.
- Always insure that equipment is in good working order.

#### **Question:** What is a 3D archery tournament?

**Answer:** The best description I can offer is this. It is a 30 target course [15 known distances and 15 unknown distances] that we set up in the woods to best replicate real life hunting situations. Archers are scored by where they hit the animal. Our Club Shoots are very informal and a great way to experience archery even if you have no intention of ever hunting. Please take a day and come out to one of our club shoots and I promise, you will not be disappointed. It is a great way to introduce kids into the outdoors and archery is a great family activity.


