

!!! ACTION ALERT !!!

It appears we continue to have an issue with the front gate being left unlocked and/or open by members accessing the property. It is important that all members ensure they close and lock the gate behind them both coming into and leaving the <u>range</u>.

We have had a number of situations resulting from unauthorized people accessing our property and damaging targets and structures and ensuring our gate is locked may help keep these people out. We have also had a situation where someone came in with an open gate and was locked in when the member left, resulting in a Board Member having to drive to the property to let the person out.

The only exception to this rule is if a Board Member is conducting a tour or work party, or on days when we have shoots, as these events are open to the public.

COWTOWN BOWMEN CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT FOR 2013

Starting this year, 2013, we have altered the Club Championship format to better resemble how it was with our club several years ago. We assembled a committee of Board Members who looked at various formats and presented those to the Board for consideration. The Board passed the following change in format a few months ago and we now have all of the details ironed out and ready to unveil.

As a Board, we have decided to go to a single Club Champion format [details below]. This will allow us to set aside budget for a very nice buckle for our Club Champion, and Class winners will be honored on a board to be built and displayed at the range. Class winners will be notified of their handicap, of which has been developed by two of our board members, who will not be competing for the Club Championship. The handicap paperwork was presented to the board, sealed with both signatures on the seal, and the Club President will hold until the day of the Club Championship, at which time the handicaps will be allotted.

We feel this will make our Championship more exciting as well as allow us to better allocate club funds to expenditures that benefit more of the membership, as last year we had a number of classes that did not have more than one person qualify for the Club Championship.

Club Champion

Rules_

- You must be a club member before you turn in a score card.
- You can only enter one class...first score turned in will determine your class.
- You must shoot (2) club shoots.
- The average of your (2) highest scores will determine your standings in your class.
- The Class Leaders will shoot together at the Club Championship Shoot.
- A handicap system will be given to each Class Leader...details of the handicap will be announced at the Club Championship Shoot.
- Highest score with handicap will be the Club Champion

There will be ONLY one Club Champion







SOAPING ARROWS FOR 3D SHOOTS

Why are my arrows hard to pull from some targets?

On the 3d practice range the targets are hard to pull because after sitting in the weather the foam hardens. There is nothing we can do about this.

Some of our tournament targets have been repaired using a 3-d repair kit. We had these targets repaired rather than replacing them. To replace a target it cost from \$110-\$350 depending on the target. We can repair them for \$80 per target.

One thing you can do to make it easier to pull arrows is to use an arrow lube. Scorpion Venom and Woodies are two brands of arrow lube. Pam cooking spray also works well. Another popular way is to rub bar soap on the end of your arrow. If you use one of these methods it will help you pull your arrows and it will increase the life of our targets.

ATTN: CROSSBOW SHOOTERS

Now that Cowtown members can shoot crossbows at club ranges and club level events, we need to ensure that all crossbow shooters adhere to strict safety practices.

Please do not cock the string, or load a crossbow bolt until it is your turn to shoot, and you are facing the target downrange. Please keep the arrow pointed downrange at all times and do not allow the crossbow to be aimed at the sky at any time. If we have a errant shot, it could have very serious implications. As long as these and regular range safety rules are followed we will continue to allow crossbow shooters a place to enjoy this form of archery.


