CASH MONEY PAYOUTS FOR CLUB LEVEL SHOOTS

At the end of last year's shooting season, the Club made the decision to offer up a cash payout as part of the Club Level shoots. We have finalized this format.

Any shooter wishing to be part of the cash payout, will pay an additional \$5 per shoot, of which will be paid out to the winners of each class. Payout will pay 1 spot for every 5 shooters in the class so if any given class has 3 shooters, the payout will be to 1st place only. If a class has 7 shooters, then it pays 1st and 2nd. And so on and so forth.

Also if a member helps set up the shoot, their shoot fee is paid for the shoot, but the shooter is required to still pay the additional \$5 for the payout if they choose to take part in the payout. Shoot scores will still be tabulated for Club Championship standings for all shooters as it is not required to be in the Payout shoot for your score to count for Club Score.

Question: I have never shot a 3D Tournament, how do they work and can anyone shoot in them?

Answer: With the increase in new shooters to the club and the 3D shoot scene, here are some pointers for those just starting out. All of the shoots Cowtown Bowmen host are open to the public, so anyone can come and shoot. On Club Level 3D shoots, we set up 30 targets, first 15 known distance, last 15 unknown distance. You shoot from a stake designated in color for the class you will shoot in, which is determined by what you are shooting. You shoot one arrow at each target and have one person in your group keep scores. Club Level 3D shoots are a great way to spend time in the outdoors, enjoying archery. Please don't hesitate to ask another member if you need any help or guidance, we all were new at it once upon a time. ©




