WHITE SETTLEMENT YOUTH ARCHERY PROGRAM

On May 24 we had the White Settlement Youth Archery program students come to the range (ages 6-14). It was looking like storms would hit and we were very fortunate that we only received a few sprinkles from 5-8 during the shoot. Targets were taken down with Tornado sirens blaring in the background. This was a bit un-nerving but there were never any signs of bad weather at the range. We set them a Midway style course to shoot for their final class. We have worked for 8 weeks on form and accuracy using several different types of games to make it fun. This was a combination of those types of exercises with scoring, which also tested their math skills. We had 6 3D targets set from 4yds-12 yds using 10-8-5-0 scoring method. There was a 20 yd long shot challenge, which they were given 3 shots and 2 separate 10 yd bales all using a 10-8-5-0 scoring. With a possible 150 for a perfect score, we had several students achieve scores of 120 or higher. The high score of 133 was posted in a challenge between 2 of the students and 2 of the adults who came to help out. Geoff Klein, Tracy Smith and Carl Ashford came out to help setup and Help with scoring of the young archers. A Special THANKS goes to those individuals; it would have been very hard to pull off without their help. I am grateful to them ALL. This was the 2nd year for the kids to come on the final night. The program has gain popularity and I was asked to teach another 8-week class for June-July. The final class will be at the range and I hope to have better weather and a much larger turnout. I will be asking for volunteers again as it gets closer to the finals.


