Please email all questions that you would like published to the above newsletter email account and we will do our best to get them in our next monthly newsletter.

Question: During a 3D shoot, how many arrows do I shoot at each target?

Answer: Typically, 3D shoots are 30 targets and the shooter fires one arrow at each target. There are exceptions like some of the traditional shoots we host, they are allowed a certain number of mulligans [do overs] in which the archer is allowed to shoot another arrow and take the second score, better or worse.


