All of us on the board would like to wish everyone a very Happy New Years and are very exciting for the coming year at Cowtown. We have set a budget for the coming year and there are great things in store for our wonderful club and its awesome members.

We will be arranging a work party to get the Field Archery range started and hope to have it completed as soon as possible. We have our schedule set for our 3D shoots, including our two Traditional shoots and have even added a Toys for Tots donation shoot for this coming December [more details to follow as soon as we get them ironed out].

On the club level, you will notice we added two weekend dates, shoots #2 & #3. We did this because looking at the numbers from 2013, we seen we had about the same number of shooters on both Saturday and Sunday club shoots, even though we know that there are some of us who can only make it to one or the other. By adding these weekend club shoots, we hope to be able to draw more archers to our club level shoots, which will only help grow our club. These shoots will be a Saturday start at 10am, which will allow our work party to set up the range that morning prior to the shoot, cards in Saturday by 3pm. Sunday shoot times during weekend events will be starting at 8am, with cards in by 12pm noon, awards to immediately follow. More details on club level shoots in write up below.

We will also be continuing our 'Bring a Bow Buddy' program, where if you have a friend who has not been a member the previous year, join our club and puts your name in the 'referred by' spot on their application, then you will receive a \$10 discount off your next year's membership. In 2013 we had 15 new members brought in to the club via this program and believe it can help increase the clubs numbers again in 2014.



We are also considering doing a combined 3D/Field shoot, more to follow as soon as we get those details figured out as well.

NEW SCORING FOR COWTOWN CLUB SHOOTS

We are changing our scoring for club shoots in an effort to help extend the life of our targets as well as simplify it for new shooters we hope to draw to our club shoots this year. We will be using the IBO center 11 scoring system, with 12's and 14's no longer in play. In the past we had followed ASA scoring, but with last year's changes, we stayed the same with split 12's and 14 still in play, which we found added some confusion, especially for those new to the sport.

COWTOWN CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT CHANGES

The board also decided on a new format for determining our Club Championship. Last year we tried something new with the handicap format and we do feel it added some excitement to the club championship format, a side effect of that was fewer people in the running for our club title. This year's format was developed by a committee of members led by a board member and looks very promising to make the 2014 Club Championship a very exciting thing. Thank you all of those that volunteered for the committee and worked so hard on this format.

- There will be awards given out at Club Shoots, so be sure to stick around after the event to see who won and collect awards.
- Must shoot 3 club shoots to qualify for Club Championship running. Those three scores will be averaged and shooters will be arranged in 'flights' at Championship shoot which will have a shotgun 10am start time. The next four in each class will be arranged in 'flights' as well and so will the third group. Awards given will be a buckle, a trophy and a medallion for all classes youth and above. Cubs and younger will receive trophies and medallions.

ARE YOU READY FOR SOME FIELD ARCHERY??? Work Party Scheduled for Jan. 11th @ 9am


