NEW BENCHES COMING SOON TO COWTOWN BOWMEN

Keep your eye out for the new benches we are working on for the Field / 3D Practice ranges as well as the woods where we hold our shoots. These benches are being built using wood reclaimed from our very own woods. They are being milled to 3" thick slabs that will be mounted on log bases. This is a project spearheaded by Bob Combest. Kevin & Chuck Hubbard, Donnie Bowman and Bob Combest have been rounding up the wood needed to make these benches. Bryan Sharp donated use of his truck and flatbead trailer to haul the logs to the mill with Bob. From there the slabs were taken to Bob's, where they are getting the top side routed on the edges, as well as a fresh coat of stain/sealer with the help from Dave Gibson. We are very excited for this project to be complete so watch for volunteer opportunities to help us get these set.

Cowtown Bowmen Front Gate Vandalism/Break in/Left Open

Cowtown members,

It appears that the front gate was either left unlocked, or someone attempted to break 'out' of the range yesterday/last night as this morning when one of the board members went to the range this is the condition of the gate. The lock was intact and actually had the correct combination still on it, so that could indicate that the last person at the range left the combo unlocked and the gate just pulled closed [one thought is that if this was the case, the wind could have swung the gate open then closed enough to bend the lock tang.

I cannot stress enough the importance of each of us making sure the gate is locked, and the combo is spun on the lock so that none of the combination is visible, coming in and leaving the range. We are having a chain put on the gate to better secure the locking of it as the tang on the gate bends rather easily and could be a weak point if someone wanted to break in. Several clubs in the metroplex have experienced severe loss due to break ins, theft of club property and vandalism. We have been very fortunate up until this point and are confident that with everyone's help, we can ensure that the clubs property, our property, remains secure.

Thank you for your time and efforts, and if at any time you see the gate left open, or unlocked, please report it to one of the board members and we will address it immediately. The only time the gate is allowed to be left open is if we are holding a shoot, or having a work party at the range. Otherwise it has to be locked at all times, and the combo spun so all numbers are not on the combination.







