### DFW Shooter Of the Year / Club Of the Year

Cowtown Bowmen and our neighboring clubs and shops are happy to announce a new shooting circuit, for local clubs members to compete against one another, head to head, and hopefully foster some good ole fashioned rivalries, all while boosting some of our club shoot attendances. See below for the info, and we hope to see you out and about representing Cowtown:

#### **SOY Rules**

30 Animal set up - ASA scoring

1st 15 known and 2nd 15 unknown (SOY shooters will be responsible to have range finders for the 15 known targets as not all clubs set  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$ .)

<u>Must shoot 4 out of 5 shoots to be considered for shooter of the year.</u> Highest 4 shoot total wins in each class for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each class so if you shoot in all 5 your lowest score will be dropped.

\$10 per person to shoot kids 12 and under shoot free

Awards will be given out at the last SOY shoot and then scores and results will be posted on each clubs web sites if the winner cannot attend the last shoot arrangements will be made to get the awards to them.

#### **COY Rules**

Each club will get a point for each shooter that attends a SOY shoot with a max of 10 points awarded. (The club that hosts the shoot will not be awarded participation points) The goal is to help out our fellow clubs drive their shoot participation levels.

Each club will also get the following points awarded to them if one of their shooter places in the top 3 for each shoot in their class. 1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points and 3rd = 1 point

#### Newest Report from the Ft Worth Audubon Bird Watching Group

It was an overcast day with an occasional light rain. The bright spot in our territory was the Cowtown Bowman's property. When we first arrived it seemed as if every tree around the parking area had multiple American Robins. We counted over 150 just in that immediate area. As we circled around the trails, we heard the distinctive call of Cedar Waxwings. They like to cluster together while feeding and focus on trees and shrubs with berries. It was difficult to count them as they searched for food, but we identified almost 200! Of the 17 different territories in the Fort Worth Audubon Circle, ours had the largest numbers of Robins and Waxwings. Many areas didn't even see one Waxwing!




