## **Cowtown Bowmen is looking for someone to fill our Traditional Shoot Director position.**

If you, or someone you know would be interested, please let a board member know as soon as possible as we will be selecting someone for this vacant position at the November 16th monthly meeting at Spring Creek BBQ in Lake Worth @ 7pm. See below for job description as per the club's bylaws.

The club will be hosting (2) traditional only shoots in 2015, our Annual Winter Traditional Shoot, Feb. 27-28, 2015 and the Texas Recurve Championship, April 23-24, 2015. We are working with the city to secure an exemption for these tow shoots to allow overnight camping for our participants as well, so next year should be very exciting for Cowtown's trad shoots.

#### L. The Traditional Director shall:

1. Be responsible for all organization level shoots and regional shoots pertaining to traditional archery only, including the preparation and mailing of announcements, registration, posting of scores and verifying and maintaining a record of all awards. The Traditional Director will work closely with the Range Captains in setting up for all the organization and state level shoots.

2. Preparation and presentation of a budget for all expected expenses to a regular meeting of the membership for approval, and keeping the membership informed of any needed changes.

3. Generate advertising pieces on the various tournaments and their placement in publications in a timely and useful manner. Mailing of advertising pieces to interested clubs, businesses, manufacturers, and shooters.

4. Preparation of all forms needed to process paperwork at the shoots. Preparation of handouts and announcements to be read at the tournament. Preparation of the agenda for the tournament.

5. Organization of the registration, score boarding, and awards presentation for the tournaments including the design and purchase of awards after approval by the membership.

6. Have on hand and be familiar with all published organization and association rules pertinent to the shoot in progress. Enforcing all organization and association regulations, and serving as the final authority on all decisions and rulings at the tournament.


7. Maintaining records on the results of each shoot and filing all required reports with the association in questions.

8. Reporting results to all archery publications which may have an interest as well as the Editor and Web Master.

9. Assume any other duties pertinent to the position.

### **BIG CHANGES FOR DFWSOY IN 2016!!!**

We have completed our 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting for the DFWSOY circuit and there are some exciting changes coming this next year. First off, the circuit will now be called the NTXSOY as opposed to the DFWSOY. This is being done for two reasons, first to align to our new cooperative website [see more info below] and secondly because we have added another club to the mix that is not in the metroplex. This will also allow for better expansion as this circuit gains popularity as we foresee happening.

The above banner shows the new website, <u>www.ntxarchery.com</u>, which is being run by Cowtown's very own Brian White, with the help of his friend and girlfriend. This website will be a place for all of the participating clubs to have links to our own websites, but also will be the main point for all NTXSOY scores and the entire schedules for all of the clubs that are part of this cooperative circuit.

At this time, there are a total of (5) clubs for the 2016 year and the decision has been made to allow all of each of our club shoots to be eligible SOY and COY shoots. This means that you can go to any of the other club shoots for the other clubs and have the score applied to your SOY totals. Please make sure to tell them which club you are there to represent as we will still be getting Club of the Year [COY] points for anyone shooting the NTXSOY circuit. To be eligible for Shooter of the Year [SOY] awards, you will need to shoot at least ONE (1) shoot for each of the (5) Clubs partaking. You can shoot a second club shoot and better your score, but your totals for SOY standings will be based on your best score, from each of the (5) clubs. The five clubs participating in the program are Cowtown Bowmen, Mesquite Archery Club, Irving Bowhunters, Cinnamon Creek Ranch, and Fort Grard Archery in Weatherford. COY standings will remain the same, with each club getting (1) points up to (10) for each club representative shooting in an away event, as well as (3) additional points for any representative placing in 1<sup>st</sup> in their class, (2) points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and (1) points for 3<sup>rd</sup>. Classes for the NTXSOY circuit are as follows: Men's/Women's/Senior Open, Men's/Women's/Senior Hunter, Young Adult [15-17], Youth [13-14], Cubs [12-Under].

The program committee, assembled by club reps for each participating club, has also appointed two offices to oversee the circuit and act in a leadership role for ongoing NTXSOY business. Chairman is Charles Yardley of CCR and Secretary is Steve Jennings of IBA.

Please keep an eye out for more details and let us know if you have any questions, comments, or concerns. We think this circuit still has a great opportunity to increase all of the clubs involved club shoot attendance numbers as well as continuing to build a good rivalry among those clubs. We also look forward to adding more clubs to this program in the future.

# **COWTOWN 3D PRACTICE RANGE UNDER DEVELOPMENT**


I know everyone is excited about the new 3D Practice range, and the final plan is almost ready to go. So be on the lookout for work party opportunities so you can help make this a reality.


