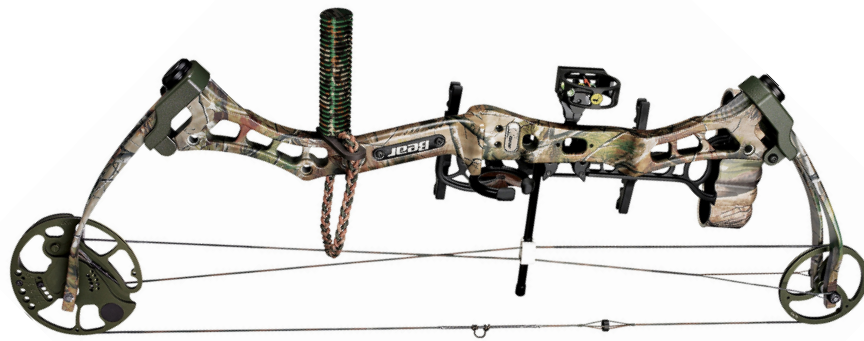

## COWTOWN BOWMEN CLUB Q & A

This is a new section of our newsletter that we will use to answer frequent questions regarding the club, meeting, funding for projects, volunteer opportunities, and range and facility rules. Please email all questions that you would like published to the above newsletter email account and we will do our best to get them in our next monthly newsletter.

**Question:** How and where does the club spend money? I went to a meeting and see that the club has a certain amount of money in the account and was just wondering where the club spends that money on.

**Answer:** The club has a base amount we try to keep in the bank every year. Our fiscal year ends on August 31<sup>st</sup> of every year. The set amount is a safety net in case the club needs to spend money that is not planned [replacing vandalized targets, catastrophic equipment failure, etc]. If the club has less than our set safety net amount, already set from the previous year, then the new lower balance as of 08/31 will be our new level. So if the following year, we have more than that amount in the account, being a not for profit organization, we will have to pay taxes on anything over that amount. This year the club instituted a budget plan for 2013, whereas we appointed chairpersons to lead committees to draft proposals for what the club could expect to spend this year. This included all awards for all shoots, all expenses like porta-potties, trash removal, target repair, new target purchases, lease payments, insurance payments, postage, keys for memberships, etc. Also at every meeting we go over the treasury report and we discuss what has been deposited and paid out of the club account. Our treasurer also makes available a current statement from our bank account 2-3 times a year, so that we can confirm his report matches exactly what our statement shows. All of this information is available to the any member and we encourage you to come to the meetings and get involved. This is a club anchored in it dedication to making Cowtown Bowmen Archery Club the absolute best it can be for all of its members.

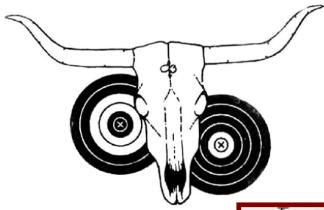

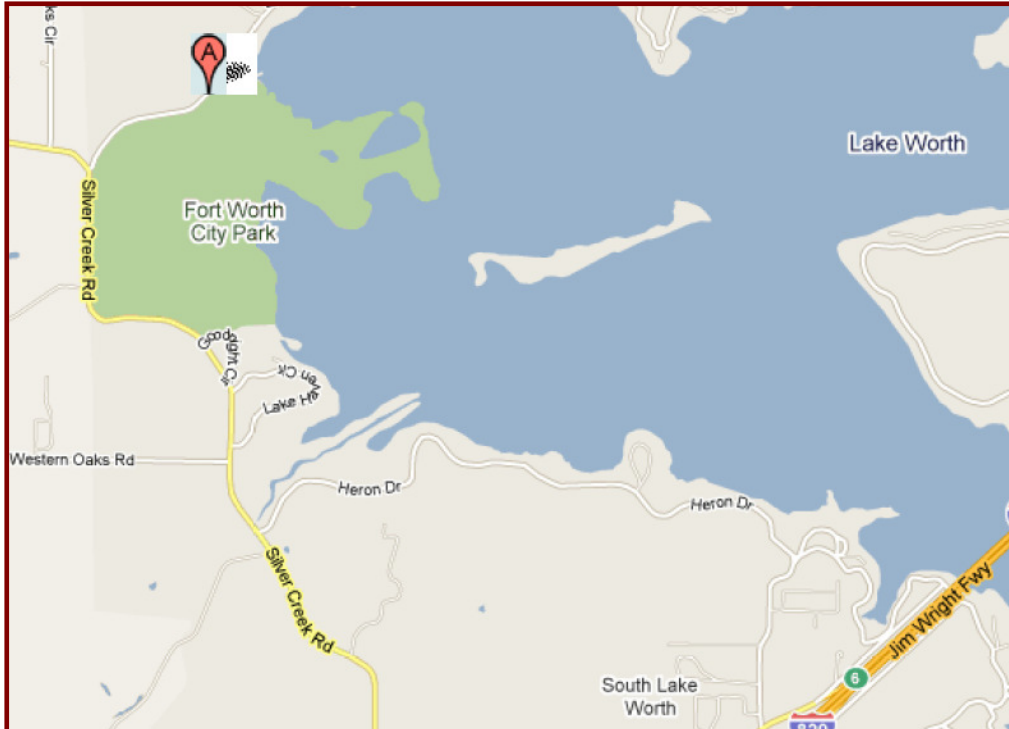
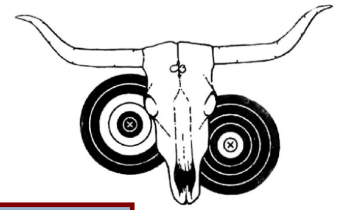
